Dear Mr. Johnson:

Re: URSU Referendum on Continued Membership

This is further to my letter to you dated March 7, 2011 and further to the mass email sent by Neil Petrich dated March 9, 2011. Since sending my letter to you on March 7, 2011, I have not heard from you. I would have expected that you would have communicated with me directly should you or your client have had any concerns with respect to the position taken by the Canadian Federation of Students and as outlined in my correspondence. You have not responded with any concern with respect to any specific breach of the agreement entered into on December 15, 2010.

As a courtesy, my client is prepared to wait until noon on March 10, 2011 for you to express any concerns so that they may be duly considered. In our view, however, the agreement is clear and, as outlined at paragraph (ii), results of the referendum were to have been announced forthwith to the students at the University of Regina and the public. To deny those students that result is an infringement of the democratic process and inconsistent with the Agreement as entered into.

I trust that this makes clear the position of the Canadian Federation of Students and will allow you an opportunity to respond.
