

Haris Khan 4 URSU President

In 2015, Haris Khan was chosen from hundreds of young leaders in Saskatchewan to receive the **CBC Future 40 award**. He is the Founder of the "Stand Up for Charity" and has raised more than \$20,000 for charitable organizations in Saskatchewan.

Last March, Khan was elected as a Vice President (External) for the University of Regina Students Union (URSU). He is the creator of **URSU Threads** (Free professional attire for students). It is the first program of its kind in Western Canada by a Student Union and has helped over **650** students with providing professional attires. This program has been instrumental in helping U of R students to start their career with confidence and one less financial burden.

Khan has been working tirelessly for the students throughout his term. Some of the highlights from his term as a Vice President (External) are; organized events/campaigns like Clothing Drive for URSU Threads, Canada 150 BBQ Party, Welcome Week 2017, Sustainability Week 2017, Mental Wellness Week 2018, Pie in the Face Fundraiser for Regina's Hope's Home. He had also received the Spirit award 2017 by the University of Regina for his efforts.

He is currently working with nonprofit organizations and student groups in organizing the first annual URSU Equity Week on campus and also working closely with Engineers Without Borders (U of R Chapter) for developing a campaign to get the Fair-Trade designation for campus. Khan will continue building success for the campus communities if elected as President.
